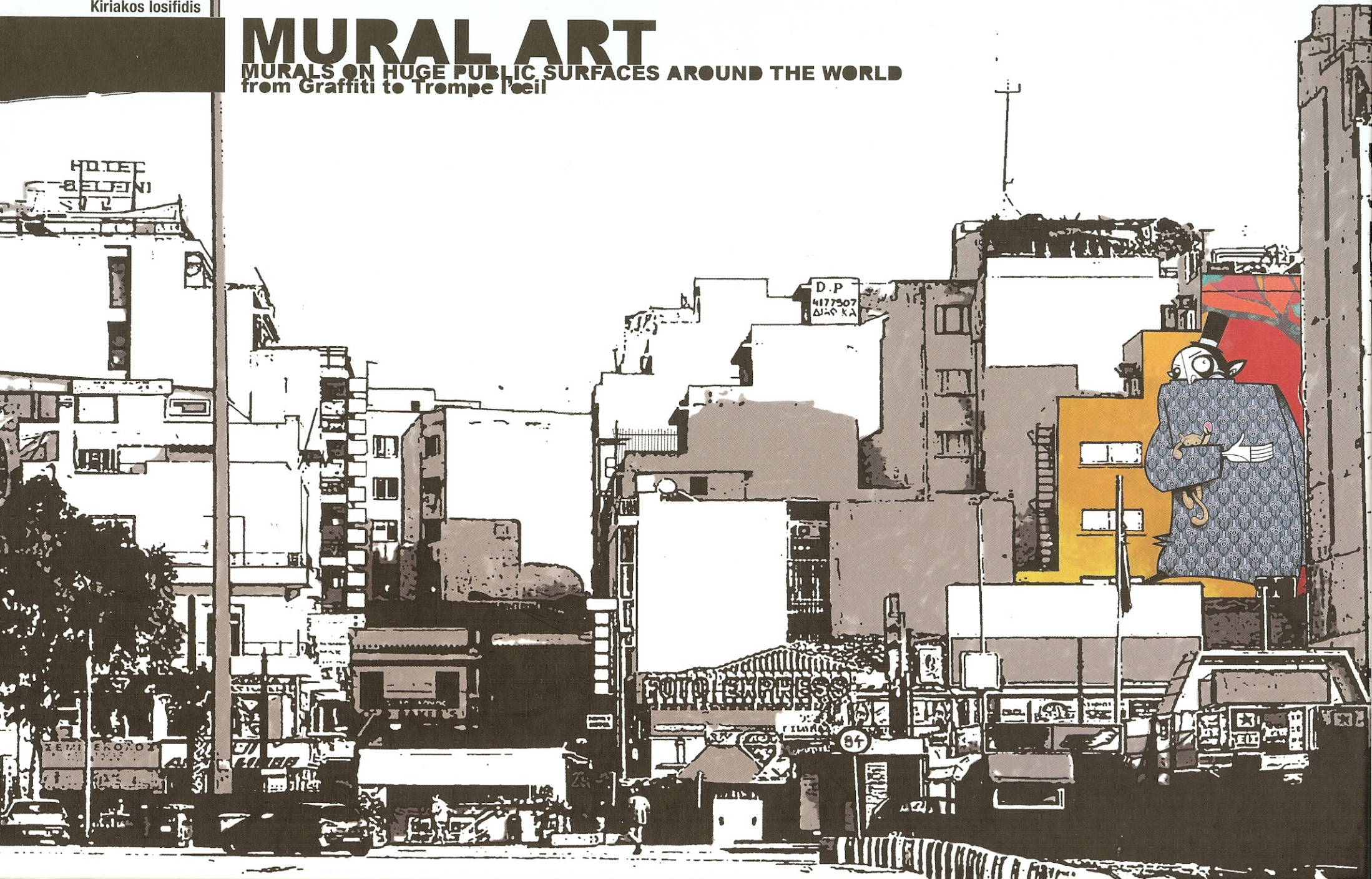

his works and murals are community involvement on issues such as environment, education, multiculturalism, and social justice. Mr. Hernandez has shown his works in numerous galleries across Oregon, Japan and Mexico.



Hector H. Hernandez received his MFA from the University of Oregon in 1999 in painting and holds a MIS in Art and Education (1995), from Oregon State University, and two degrees in Social Anthropology in Mexico City and a Bachelor of Fine Arts. He has studied art and Japanese culture in Tokyo and Osaka, Japan.

Mr. Hernandez has produced public artworks and murals throughout communities, organizations, and educational institutions in Oregon and Mexico since 1985, while developing collaborations. His murals are located at the OSU Memorial Union, Portland Community College (Rock Creek Campus), Parks and Recreations, and Wilsonville Art and Cultural Council, among others.

Currently Mr. Hernandez is working on community mural projects and public art pieces for the FHDC (Farm workers Corporation). Public art projects including monument pieces and murals are executed with various techniques such as mosaics, tile work, acrylics, and non-woven fabric.

Mr. Hernandez is projecting future public art works in mixed media, combining mosaic, tiles, in which plastic integration of various art disciplines, such as architecture, sculpture and painting will merge.
